## japanese craft\_fabric-cartonnage

with Kiyomi Huber



To give gifts in decorative fabric-covered boxes is common in Japan. Such boxes can also be used to store small belongings, like keys or jewellery. It is not just covered on the outside with fabric; a different pattern can be used as lining. Under Kiyomi's guidance you will learn to make your own book-style-box the size of 22 x 11 x 6 cm. This beginner's course includes a brief theoretical presentation. Your own favorite fabric (medium thick linen or cotton) will give the box a personal note. If you prefer Kiyomi's fabric, you can buy it from her. If possible, bring scissors and a small towel.
